



### TCCHD Public COVID Vaccine Clinics – July 2023

Trumbull County Combined Health District (TCCHD) will host COVID-19/Flu vaccine clinics during the month of July, 2023. Clinics will offer mRNA bivalent vaccine, which strengthens protection against the original COVID-19 strain, as well as currently circulating Omicron variants.

Persons aged 6 years – 64 years, who have had one or more monovalent doses but no bivalent dose, may receive the bivalent vaccine if at least 4 months have transpired since their last dosage. Those who are in that age group, and have already received a bivalent dose, are not eligible for a second bivalent dose.

Individuals 65 or older, who have received one bivalent dose, may receive a second if at least 4 months since their last dosage.

TCCHD has COVID bivalent vaccine for 6 months and older. **A parent must accompany all children under the age of 18 years.**

Unless you are receiving your very first dose, please be sure to bring your vaccine card with you to your appointment.
