
Also, please remember that N95 masks continue to offer the best level of protection against Covid-19 (see Industry News) according to the CDC.

### Covid-19 Vaccine Clinics

The TCCHD has been and continues to work diligently against the Covid-19 virus and Pandemic within Trumbull County. The TCCHD continues to hold Covid-19 vaccination clinics on a weekly basis at the Eastwood Mall on Tuesday's and Thursday's from 5:00pm to 7:00pm, and the first Saturday of every month from 10:00am to 12:00pm. All 3 vaccinations (Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson) are generally available. Covid-19 booster shots are also available!

### Covid-19 Testing

Currently the TCCHD is out of over the counter and home Covid-19 test kits. There has been a statewide surge of requests for kits and TCCHD does not know when the kits ordered will arrive. Meanwhile, continue to mask, maintain safe distance from others, wash your hands, and get vaccinated. These measures will help protect you from COVID-19.

### Covid-19 Data

#### As of January 14, 2022:

- The TCCHD has administered approximately 41,500 doses of the Covid-19 Vaccine.
- 20,757 are first doses,
- 17,644 are second doses,
- 3,099 are third/booster doses.
- The TCCHD continues to receive on average 100 cases of Covid-19 daily.

### TCCHD History

On February 26, 1953, The TCGHD adopted regulation 125, page 590 of the Ohio Public Health Manual regarding the keeping of hogs at private residences.

On February 21, 1920, Dr. Jonas E. King, Girard, Ohio, was appointed Health Commissioner of Trumbull County.

The test kits start to ship near the end of January. Currently, only one order of 4 is allowed per household. U.S. residents may also call 1-800-232-0233 for assistance with placing an order.
